



QUIZOTICA-2018

1. General Guideline:

- i. The students appearing or appeared **Class-10** examination in 2018 are only eligible to participate in Quizotica-2018.
- ii. The competition will be held in two rounds : **Preliminary Round (On-line Test) & Final Round (Written & Oral)**
- iii. The eligible students can participate only after applying in the on-line registration process.
- iv. No registration fee shall be charged from the applicant.
- v. The participants shall have to register their names in the website: **www.nilachalpolytechnic.org** by filling up the required information.
- vi. In the preliminary round the test will be conducted in online mode and top 300 participants shall be shortlisted for the final round.
- vii. The final round will be conducted in two phases : **Written And Oral**
- viii. In the first phase 300 participants shall participate in the written test and the **best 6** participants will be selected for the final phase, which will be conducted orally.

2. Mock Test (Practice Test):

- i. For convenience of the participants mock test (Practice Test) shall be conducted prior to the schedule of the online test.
- ii. In the mock test participants will have to answer 10 MCQ in 15 minutes of duration. It is to be noted that the Mock Test is only meant to familiarize the participants to aware them about the On-line Test process. The marks of this test will not be evaluated or consider for the Main Quiz Test. Further the Mock Test is also optional.

3. Guideline for online test (Preliminary Round) :

- i. There will be 30 nos. of Multiple Choice Questions to be answered in 30 minutes.
- ii. The questions shall be based on Class 10th standard (Mathematics, Science, History, Geography, English and current GK etc.).
- iii. 2 marks shall be awarded for each correct answer and 1 mark shall be deducted for each wrong answer.
- iv. The participants shall appear the online test from any **Internet Point** or through any **Smart Phone** in the specified schedule for the test. The details of Quiz shall be available through local daily Newspaper The Prameya and also in the mentioned website.
- v. The participants will visit the website : **www.nilachalpolytechnic.org** and login by using the **login id** and **password** issued to them.
- vi. Then **click** on to the **online test**.
- vii. Answer the questions by putting **tick mark** on the appropriate option.
- viii. Then click on the **submit** button.

4.Guideline for Final Round Competition:

The final round of competition will be held at Nilachal Polytechnic, Bhubaneswar in the following two phases.

(a) First Phase (Written Test) :

- i. There will be **50** numbers of multiple choice questions with each question having four options and the participant shall be required to select only one option.
- ii. The duration shall be of **50** minutes.
- iii. **Four** marks will be awarded for each correct answer and **1 mark** shall be deducted for each wrong answer. For un-attempted questions no marks shall be added or deducted.
- iv. The questions shall be based on Class 10th standard (Mathematics, Science, History, Geography , English and current GK etc.).
- v. On the basis of marks secured in the written test top 6 participants shall be selected for final phase of the competition.

(b) Final Phase (Oral) :

- i. The Final Phase shall be conducted among the top 6 participants.
- ii. The competition shall be held in **7 sub rounds** including **rapid fire round.(Topics : Current affairs, Science, Geography, Art & Culture, Sports, Film & Television, Mythology)**
- iii. The sub rounds may also include **Audio / Visual** based quiz.
- iv. For each correct answer (except rapid fire round) 10 marks shall be awarded to the 1st successfully answered participant and 5 marks for the next correctly answered participant if question is passed on.
- v. In the rapid fire round 5 questions shall be asked to a participant with 5 marks for each correct answer and questions of this round cannot be passed on to the other participants.
- vi. On the basis of marks secured Winner, Runners-up and Merit Awards shall be given.
- vii. If two participants secure equal marks then the merit shall be decided on the basis of additional rapid fire round.

5.Prizes

Winner – (1)	:	Cash Rs. 25,000/-, Trophy & Certificate
Runners-up – (1)	:	Cash Rs. 10,000/- & Certificate
Merit Award – (4)	:	Cash Rs. 2,000/- each & Certificate

In addition to the above prizes, consolation prizes shall also be awarded to 90 nos. of other participants based on the performance in the 1st round written test.

Consolation Prizes (Based on Merit in written test) :

Rank 7 to 36	:	Cash Rs. 1,000/- each and Certificate
Rank 37 to 100	:	Cash Rs. 500/- each and Certificate
